2. **PINOT GRIGIO IGT VENIZE 2006** £ 6.95 £ 17.95  
Italy  
Beautifully light, vibrant white to be appreciated for its zesty, citrus character and refreshing quality.
3. **NOSTROS, RESERVA SAUVIGNON BLANC** £ 6.95 £ 17.95  
Chile  
Sourced from Chile's premium Sauvignon Blanc region, Casablanca, this is a pure, exuberantly fruity Sauvignon packed full of grassy, tropical fruit. Instantly refreshing and moreish with a lovely tangy finish.
4. **ZEPHYR SAUVIGNON BLANC 2007** £ 32.45  
New Zealand  
Intensely aromatic with amazing aromas of guava, mango, passion fruit, asparagus and grass which lead through to a palate of richly textured, green tropical fruits. Stunning.
